Responsible Internet Use

As part of your child's curriculum and the development of ICT skills, we are providing supervised access to the Internet, and use of new technologies, such as the iPad. We believe that the use of the World Wide Web and e-mail is worthwhile and is an essential skill for children as they grow up in the modern world. Please would you read the attached 'E-Safety' document, and sign and return the consent form so that your child may use the internet and other new technologies at school.

IF THIS FORM IS NOT RETURNED, YOUR CHILD WILL NOT BE ABLE TO USE THE INTERNET OR IPADS IN SCHOOL.

Our school Internet provider operates a filtering system that restricts access to inappropriate materials. This may not be the case at home and we can provide references to information on safe Internet access if you wish. We also have leaflets and information from national bodies on our website that explain the issues further.

Whilst every endeavour is made to ensure that suitable restrictions are placed on the ability of children to access inappropriate materials, the School cannot be held responsible for the nature or content of materials accessed through the Internet. The School will not be liable for any damages arising from your child's use of the Internet facilities.

We never open e-mails sent by anyone we don't know.






We never use Internet chat rooms.
