Please note, we will only be asking for your permission once whilst your child remains at All Saints. If for any reason circumstances change and you need to amend these consents then please let the school office know as soon as possible.

PLEASE NOTE IF YOU PROCEED TO SIGN THE ATTACHED PERMISSION FORM THEN YOU ARE GIVING YOUR CONSENT TO ALL OF THESE ITEMS. Please delete any items that you do not want to give your permission to by drawing a line through them.

In Brief

Copyright Permission: Permission to allow us to issue copies of your child's work i.e. art work, to the Press for example.

Sex Education: At the present time only applicable to Year 4 girls and we will write to you separately for your permission.

Data Exchange: Data Exchange only takes place between different schools, LA, NHS and Parents.

School Visit: Any Educational/field trips that take place during school hours will be notified by a separate letter but occasionally we may take the children on local visits i.e. to Ballington Wood, All Saints Church, Leek Town and sometimes these visits would not be notified by letter. By signing the form you are giving your consent to these school visits.

Emergency Medical: If your child is taken seriously ill either in school or on a school outing we will in the first instance dial 999. You will be giving your permission to allow us to do this and make any decisions if urgently required on your behalf. PLEASE NOTE that if your child is on prescribed medication and they need to take this during school hours then you must complete a medical form at the school office.

Swimming: At the present time only applicable to year 4 children and you will be notified by letter separately when applicable

Use of Sunscreen: During hot periods we recommend that you apply sunscreen to your child before they start school in the morning. Sometimes this needs reapplying and encourage children to do this themselves. Please see letter attached for further details.

Walk to Church: The school often walks to All Saints Church during different parts of the school term i.e. to celebrate harvest, hot cross fun day, leavers service. To enable us to do this we do need your permission.

Walk to Local Field Trips: We often take the children on walks around the local area i.e. Leek Town center to look at the history of the town, Ballington Wood etc. Again we need your permission to do this.

Photograph/Video Image: Please see letter attached

Use of ICT: Please see E. Safety rules attached. We appreciate that if your child is in the Nursery setting than they are too young to understand the pupil's agreement. We will ask your child to sign this part of the agreement when they move into Reception class.

Face Painting: Normally we ask for permission to put face paints on your child for the school production i.e. the nativity or the summer play. During the summer we may have Seaside Days when again your child's face may be painted. If your child is allergic to face paints then please delete this from the permission form before signing

Food Tasting: To support the Curriculum we sometimes have food tasting session's i.e. foods from different cultures, If your child suffers from a food allergy please ensure that you let the school office know immediately. We presently have a child in school with a nut allergy and we are sure that you are all aware of the dangers of food allergies and to ensure that the child is not put at any risk please do not send your own children into school with any nuts or food products that contain nuts or trace of nuts. We apologise for any inconvenience but obviously a child's health and wellbeing is our paramount importance and we would therefore appreciate your co-operation. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.

Choir Visits Children in year 4 can join the School Choir. The choir makes visits to local businesses i.e. Britannia Building Society, local Residential homes. By signing the permission form you are also giving permission for your child to be heard on the Local Radio (if applicable).

Coach Travel: If your child is taken by coach i.e. on a school trip, school tournament or swimming, they will be expected to be responsible enough to wear any seatbelt provided until informed it may be released.
