Nursery Provision

All Saints' First School works in partnership with All Saints' Kids Club to provide complete wraparound provision for all 3 and 4 year old children. All children are entitled to 15 hours Nursery provision from the term AFTER their 3rd birthday. In addition, parents may be eligible for an additional 15 hours Nursery provision (or may choose to pay for this provision if not eligible).

All Saints' Kids Club offers before and after the school day (Breakfast and Tea Club) provision. This is usually paid provision. However, unused childcare hours can also be used for this provision.

Together, All Saints' School and All Saints' Kids Club offer provision for 5 days per week from 7.30am to 6pm in the following way.



What free provision can I access?

All Saint's First School offers 15 hours Nursery Provision, which can be accessed the term following your child's third birthday.

This can be taken as 5 morning sessions.

In addition, *if you are eligible*, you will be able to access 15 further hours *free* provision through All Saints' Kids Club. To be eligible:

- Your child must be three or four years old
- Both parent must be working – or the sole parent is working in a lone parent family
- Each parent earns, on average, a weekly minimum equivalent to 16 hours at national minimum wage
- Each parent must have an annual income less than £100,000 and live in England

If you meet these criteria you will be able to apply for the additional 15 hours provision through an online portal www.childcarechoices.gov.uk.

You need to apply for a place for Nursery directly with the school. An application form is on the school website, or can be requested in the school office.

What if I am not eligible for the additional free provision or would like more than 30 hours?

This isn't a problem. We offer paid provision, and you are able to access provision from 7.30am to 6pm every day. Price lists and further information are available from All Saints' Kids Club Office in the Community Building or on our website.

How can I organise my sessions?

Universal hours will be allocated in the mornings (5 x 3 hour sessions).

Additional hours will be allocated in the afternoons (5 x 3 sessions).

Parents may also request to pay for afternoon sessions, if they are not eligible for additional hours childcare – see below.

You may accept all sessions, or some of them. However, if sessions are not accepted, they will be offered to other children, and you will not be able to change days.

Any unallocated hours can be used to fund Before and After School club, but not other Nursery sessions.

What if I choose to pay for afternoon Nursery Sessions (12pm-3pm)?

Paid sessions are agreed on a termly basis and are non-refundable. Parents will be asked to pay £150 per term for each afternoon attended. E.g. A parent who requests 3 afternoon sessions will be charged £450 per term (3 x £150). This may be split into 4 equal monthly payments of £112.50.

What sessions are best?

For your child's education it is extremely important to attend Nursery every day to ensure your child has access to the full Early Years curriculum. We would encourage this whenever possible.

How do I arrange my child's provision?

- Complete the Nursery application form, indicating your preferred sessions, and whether you intend to apply for the additional 15 hours. Also indicate if you wish to pay for afternoon sessions.
- Complete a Kids Club application form if you require Before and After School Club sessions.

Sessions must be booked on a term-by-term basis. We are unable to swap slots on a daily or weekly basis.
